THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMARANTH

BY-LAW NO. <u>59</u> - 2018

A BY-LAW TO AMEND TOWNSHIP BY-LAW 24-2007, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR ESTABLISHING TARIFF OF FEES FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICES.

WHEREAS Section 391 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the Council may impose fees or charges for services and activities provided of done by or on behalf of the Corporation of the Township of Amaranth;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to amend By-law 24-2007 to impose fees for certain services provided by Fire Departments servicing the Township of Amaranth;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Township of Amaranth deems it necessary to amend By-Law 24-2007 Section 5.2, Charges – Failure to Obtain a Burning Permit as follows:

1. Charges – Failure to Obtain a Valid Fire Permit/Failure to Comply with a Valid Fire Permit

Any person who lights, ignites or starts or allows or causes to be lighted, ignited or started, a fire of any kind whatsoever in the open air and who by his or her action causes the summons of a fire truck and fire brigade from the *Shelburne & District Fire Department*, the *Grand Valley and District Fire Department*, or the *Town of Orangeville Fire Department*, without a valid fire permit, or failing to comply with a valid fire permit, shall be responsible to the Township of Amaranth for expenses thereby incurred for responding Fire Department Services.

2. In all other respects the provisions of By-Law 24-2007 shall remain in effect.
